

GUIDE – MANAGE YOUR S&PL GROUP PARTICIPATION

Introduction

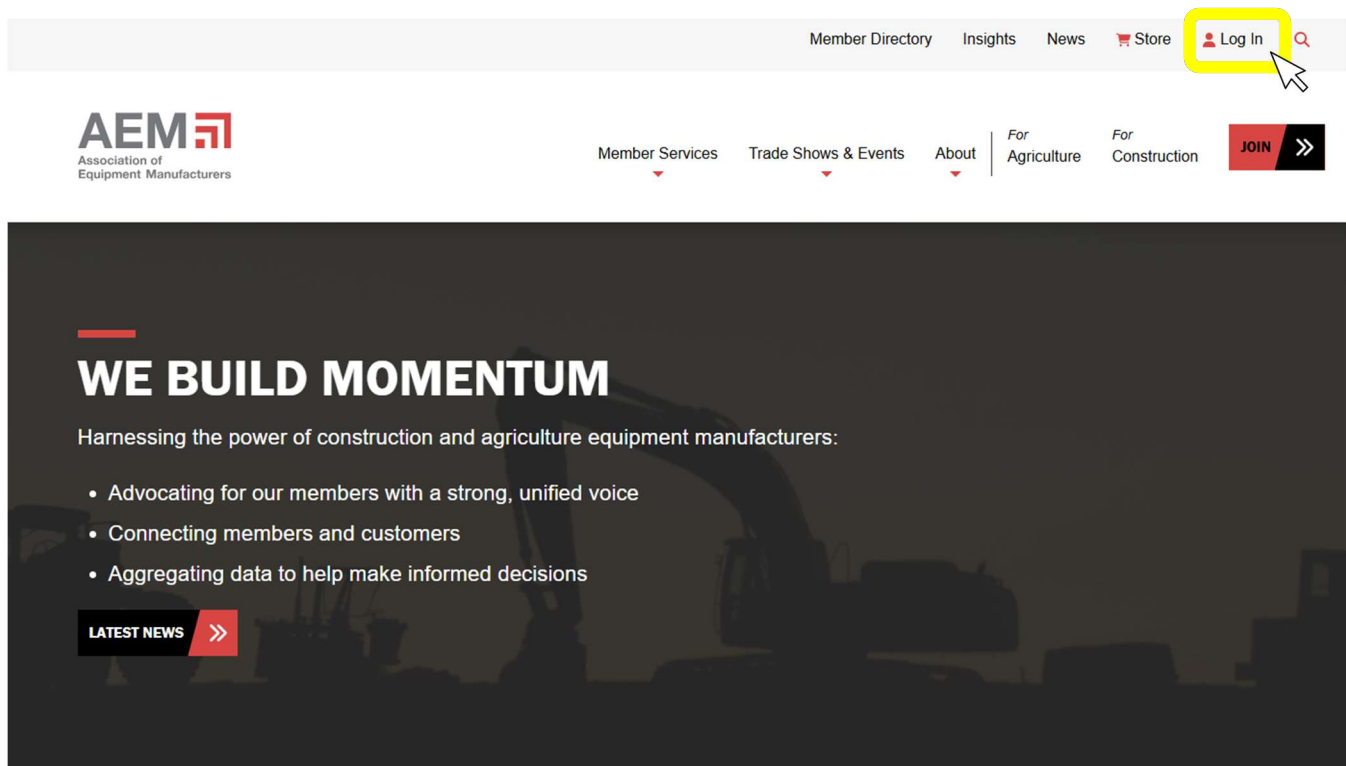
This guide introduces AEM's new self-service tool, designed to allow members to manage their participation in AEM Safety & Product Leadership (S&PL) technical groups. Whether you are joining a committee for the first time or are already actively involved, the tool provides direct control over your participation. With it, you can instantly join or leave committees and councils and gain clear visibility into the groups you're enrolled in. Please note that this tool is intended for your individual participation management in S&PL technical groups.

Guided Steps

Start by navigating to the AEM website.

In the upper right corner, select "Log In".



Next, enter your AEM account email and password, then select "Sign In".

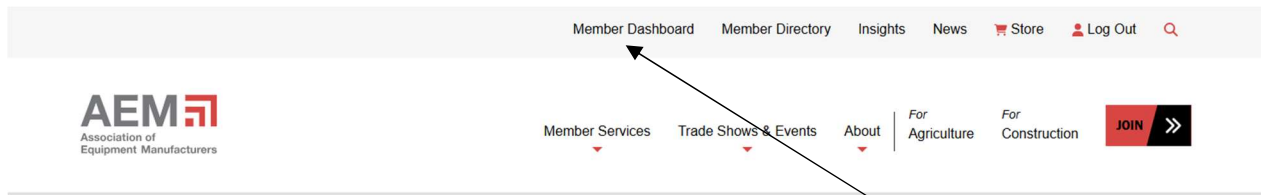

To join a council/committee, check the box next to the group's name. To leave, uncheck the box.

An unchecked box means you're not currently participating or listed on the roster.

A checked box means you're currently participating and listed on the roster.

Note: If you select a subcommittee, you'll be automatically added to its parent council.
